

Battle of Bosworth makes organically grown and certified wines from vineyards located in McLaren Vale, South Australia. Battle of Bosworth was established in 2001 by Joch Bosworth and Louise Hemsley-Smith. The wines take their name from the original Battle of Bosworth, fought on Bosworth Field, England in 1485.

The vineyards were established in the early 1970's by Joch's parents. All of the vines are certified 100% organic by Australian Certified Organic. Battle of Bosworth make wines with flavour, texture, purity and balance that best express the unique characteristics of their McLaren Vale foothills site. Battle of Bosworth wines are described as 'organically grown, traditionally vinified'.

## *Between Five Bells*

Ray Nadeson and Maree Collis are not your average winemaker/owners of a boutique winery. Both were initially trained as research scientists and hold PhD degrees in chemistry and medicine, respectively. Mid career they made the decision to pursue their alternate passion, wine. It all began with Lethbridge Wines in 1996, the wines of Lethbridge are generally single varietal wines or mirror a traditional European blend. Between Five Bells instead aims to be multi-regional, multi-varietal blends with the ultimate goal of being delicious and slurpable wines.

Between Five Bells allows Ray a sense of freedom with his winemaking, exploring texture, fermentation vessels and blending. The wines have a sense of winemaker forgoing the idea of terroir, allowing the drinker the freedom to enjoy the wines without having to worry about the grape varieties or the region in which they are grown. Ray will often use the musical analogy with his wines and Between Five Bells is his discordant jazz.

One of the most fascinating things about these wines are the beautiful & innovative labels. The labels feature graphics which are representations of data collected about each wine, for example the Red label represents the heat of the ferments, the time on skins and the ripeness of the grapes.

All Between Five Bells wines are organic, vegan and made with minimal intervention.

In 2007 Brad swapped his wine knife for a pair of secateurs and came to work vintage in McLaren Vale. In true Aussie tradition, his name was summarily changed to 'Brash' which provided a ready alias to work under the radar – Brash Higgins.

Founded in 2012, CRFT is the culmination of a long held dream between winemakers Candice Helbig & Frewin Ries.

CRFT Wines express the place where it started and the uniqueness that comes from individual sites. Each wine is made from grapes picked from a single vineyard and every bottle becomes an honest reflection of that one specific location, an untarnished sample of soil and season.

In March 2016 Candice & Frewin purchased the Arranmore Vineyard in the Piccadilly Valley, Adelaide Hills, a small 5-acre vineyard planted with Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Gruner Veltliner. They immediately converted the vineyard to organic farming and in February 2019 became NASAA Certified Organic.

Along with the Arranmore Vineyard, CRFT also sources fruit from eight vineyards across the Adelaide Hills, Barossa Valley and Eden Valley. Just two to three tonnes are picked from each block and wines are produced in small batches of about 2,000 bottles.

The winemaking philosophy is simple: preserve what the vineyard grew and create balance and harmony, leaving a minimal winemaking footprint.

After making great wine for other people, Chris Darling and Bart Arnst teamed up in 2007 to make great wine for themselves under The Darling label. With over 45 years of winemaking experience between them, Chris and Bart make regional, complex wines, that drink well on any occasion.

Chris & Bart are pioneers of the organic wine scene in New Zealand, with viticulturist Bart first experimenting with organic techniques in 1996. Bart is a founding member of Organic Winegrowers of New Zealand (OWNZ). Only certified organic grapes are used to make their wines, they find it increases quality and gives certainty to the integrity of the wines. While limiting the impact to the soil and earth, they believe organics helps you to connect with wine that is safe and can be traced to origin.

With the use of organic techniques Chris and Bart believe they are seeing an increase in quality over time, vines are allowed to come into balance, producing thicker skins and therefore greater flavour.

Wines are certified organic by BioGro New Zealand.

During a formative trip to France in 2000 Tod gained a new respect for the concept of terroir and the responsibility to future generations in caring for the land. This trip was what encouraged Tod & Debbie to take the next step & produce their own wine.

Fairbrossen is the winery and vineyards of the Bowness family. The family name and origins are from the Lake District in the North-West of England, where the phrase is often expressed at the completion of a very satisfying meal, meaning 'Full to Bursting'.

The journey began in 1995 when the Bowness family decided to establish a vineyard in the upper reaches of the renowned Wilyabrup area of Margaret River. Following 7 years of university studies and practical winemaking stints across France, California, and Australia, owner/winemaker Matt Bowness established Fairbrossen in the Perth Hills, however the allure of Margaret River was too strong to resist. In 2019 Matt & partner Steph made the call to move the whole operation, family and all, back to Margaret River where it all began. New vines were planted, old favourites were nurtured, with the new winery literally steps from their front door Matt has been able to dial in even more magic in the vineyard and the cellar.

Proudly a first generation winemaker, Matt believes in minimal intervention in both the vineyards and winery. Crafted by hand, and driven by environmental principles, artisanal winemaking and a desire to push the boundaries of convention, why not come for the ride.

La Sirène, French for 'the Siren', emerged as a natural response to a calling to create and specialise in Farmhouse & Wild Ales, in particular 'Saisons'. Saison, a style of beer little known back then and even now in Australia, was one with which they were completely enamoured and intrigued. Armed with backgrounds in Microbiology and Winemaking with the iconic Bass Phillip in Victoria and with further studies in Brewing Operations, they decided it would be their sole focus and purpose. Their dedication to this interpretive style continues to this day.

La Sirène gravitate towards using simple & natural ingredients in their rawest form such as raw grains and 100% Victorian-grown malts. Their techniques are as old as the brewing style they champion and include open vat oak fermentation, uncontrolled fermentation and 100% bottle refermentation – similar to that of Methode Champenoise (traditional champagne-making technique).

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

## 1. Invoicing and Payment

- 1.1 Payment by the Customer to Grape & Grain shall be made in cash at the time of the Customer's order unless the Customer completes the Credit Application and Grape & Grain approves the Customer's current credit rating, whereupon full payment for all invoiced Products shall be made by 30 days from date of invoice.
- 1.2 Cheques and payments shall be made payable to Grape & Grain and time for payment shall be of the essence.
- 1.3 Grape & Grain reserves the right at its discretion at any time to withdraw any credit terms and substitute cash for any order or any other terms.
- 1.4 Unless otherwise expressly appropriated by Grape & Grain, payments shall be taken to discharge the Customer's oldest debt and shall first reduce any costs or interest outstanding before reducing the principal debt. The date of Grape & Grain's invoice will be the sole indication of the date of any sale for the purpose of applying moneys paid in reduction of outstanding amounts.
- 1.5 The Customer shall pay the purchase price to Grape & Grain in Australian dollars.
- 1.6 In the event that payment is not made on or before the due date then the parties agree that Grape & Grain may, at its discretion:
  - (a) charge interest on the outstanding sum at the rate of 2% per month, calculated daily, from the due date until the date of repayment; and
  - (b) suspend, until payment, all further delivery of Products to be made pursuant to this Contract or any other contract with the Customer, in which event the Customer shall not be released from its obligations to Grape & Grain pursuant to this Contract or any such other contract.
- 1.7 The Customer acknowledges that it is liable to pay for Products provided by Grape & Grain whether or not the value of such Products exceeds the credit limit set for the Customer by Grape & Grain from time to time, or the value of such Products, together with Products already provided by Grape & Grain to the Customer, exceeds the credit limit set for the Customer by Grape & Grain from time to time.
- 1.8 Any mistake on any quotation, order, invoice, delivery docket or other document issued by Grape & Grain in relation to the supply of Products shall not be binding on Grape & Grain and Grape & Grain may in its discretion issue such amended document as is required to rectify such mistake. The Customer shall comply with Grape & Grain's amended document.
- 1.9 No negotiable instrument accepted or negotiated by Grape & Grain will be deemed payment until it has been honoured. The Customer must reimburse Grape & Grain for any charges made by Grape & Grain's bank for any negotiable instrument not met on presentation.
- 1.10 The Customer shall be liable for all costs of collection and legal fees incurred by Grape & Grain in recovering amounts payable under this Contract.

## 2. Delivery and Return of Products

- 2.1 Grape & Grain will deliver the ordered Products, at Grape & Grain's expense, to the Customer's commercial premises in metropolitan Perth, or to a transport depot in metropolitan Perth.
- 2.2 The minimum quantities which Grape & Grain will deliver are: wine, three Cartons (where a Carton is equal to 9 litres)
- 2.3 Grape & Grain will use its best endeavours to deliver the Products in accordance with its estimated delivery dates.
- 2.4 Grape & Grain will not be liable in any way whatsoever for any loss, damage or expense suffered by or incurred by the Customer which arises out of or in connection with the non-availability, delay in delivery or non-delivery or non-supply of Products.
- 2.5 In order to recognise a claim for damaged Products during transport by Grape & Grain's carriers, Grape & Grain must be notified, in writing, at the time of delivery, failing which the Products supplied will be deemed to have been received and accepted by the Customer in merchantable and faultless quality and condition at the time of receipt and Grape & Grain will have no further liability whatsoever in relation to the Products. Claims of any other nature will not be considered by Grape & Grain unless made, in writing, within 24 hours of delivery.
- 2.6 Grape & Grain will not be liable for any delays or failure to perform its obligations if such failure or delay is due to Force Majeure.

## 3. Personal Property Securities Act 2009 (PPSA)

- 3.1 If Chapter 4 of the PPSA would otherwise apply to the enforcement of a security interest in connection with these Terms and Conditions of Trade, the Customer agrees that the following provisions of the PPSA will not apply: section 95 (notice of removal of accession), to the extent that it requires the company to give notice to the Customer, section 96 (when a person with an interest in the whole may retain an accession) subsection 121(4) (enforcement of liquid assets – notice to grantor); section 125 (obligation to dispose of or retain collateral); section 130 (notice of disposal), to the extent that it requires the company to give a notice to the Customer; paragraph 132(3)(d) (contents of statement of account after disposal); subsection 132(4) (statement of account if no disposal); section 135 (notice of retention) and section 143 (reinstatement of security agreement).
- 3.2 Notices or documents required or permitted to be given to the company for the purposes of the PPSA must be given in accordance with the PPSA. The Customer consents to the company affecting a registration on the PPSA register in relation to any security interest in connection with these Terms and Conditions of Trade and the Customer agrees to provide all assistance reasonably required to facilitate this. The Customer waives the right to receive notice of a verification statement in relation to any registration on the register. In these Terms and Conditions of Trade, the following words have the respective meanings given to them in the PPSA: account, proceeds, purchase money, register, registration, security interest and verification statement.

## 4. Retention of Title

- 4.1. Property in all the Goods supplied shall remain vested in Grape & Grain and shall not pass to the Customer until all monies owing to Grape & Grain by the Customer together with all collection, repossession and/or legal costs incurred, have been paid in full.
- 4.2. The Goods, whether as separate chattels or as components, shall be stored in such a manner as to be clearly identifiable as the property of Grape & Grain until title has passed to the Customer.
- 4.3 Grape & Grain may demand at any time until title has passed to the Customer that the Customer returns the Goods or any part of them.
- 4.4. In the event that the Customer defaults in the payment of any monies owing to Grape & Grain, Grape & Grain and its employees or agents shall have the right to enter without notice upon the Customer's premises or any other premises where the Goods are known to be stored to repossess the Goods and for this purpose the Customer shall grant reasonable access rights and Grape & Grain, its employees or agents shall be entitled to do all things required to secure repossession.

## 5. Privacy Act

- 5.1 I/we agree to Grape & Grain obtaining personal information about me/us from other credit providers, whose names I/we may have provided for Grape & Grain or that may be named in a credit report, for the purpose of assessing my/our application for commercial credit made to Grape & Grain Agreement to a credit provider being given a consumer credit report to collect overdue payments on commercial credit (section 18K(1)(b), Privacy Act 1988).
- 5.2 I/we agree that Grape & Grain may obtain a consumer credit report about me/us from a credit reporting agency for the purpose of collecting overdue payments relating to commercial credit owed by me/us.

## 6. Changes in Details

The applicant(s) must inform Grape & Grain in writing within seven (7) days of any change of his/her their business or corporate structure.
